## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be organized by the Club de Mar- Mallorca (CdM) on behalf of Flying Fifteen International (FFI) and the Real Federación Española de Vela (RFEV).
- 1.2. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025- 2028 (RRS)* the International Flying Fifteen Class Rules and FFI European Championship Regulations.
- 1.3. The prescriptions of the national authority (RFEV) will apply, available at:

- 1.4. Championship Regulation 5.1. will be changed as follows:  
“5.1. The number of entries will be limited to 50 boats.”
- 1.5. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.6. The notation [NP] in a rule in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat and for which the international jury may refuse to hold a hearing. This changes RRS 60.1 and 63.2 (a).
- 1.7. The Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS)
- 1.8. RRS 90.3(e) applies.
- 1.9. RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for RRS 42 applies. RRS P2.1 is modified and the Two Turns Penalty is changed by One Turn Penalty
- 1.10. Decision of the International Jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.3

### 2. [NP][DP] ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Boats shall be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, WS Advertising Code 9.2 applies.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Flying Fifteen Class. Owners and helmsperson shall be current members of their relevant National Class Association.
- 3.2. World Sailing Eligibility shall apply.
- 3.3. The Consejo Superior de Deportes of Spanish Government and Real Federación Española de Vela published recommendations. To help preserve the integrity and safety of this event the organizing committee does not accept competitors, holding only Russian or Belarussian nationality, unless they are sailing as neutrals in accordance with World Sailing Neutrality Policy or they are sailing under a Residence Certificate issued by World Sailing in accordance with the World Sailing Eligibility Code.

The Organizing Authority may amend this rule following any further decisions made on the participation of Russian and Belarussian competitors.

- 3.3 Spanish sailor, sailors officially living in Spain or representing a Spanish Club shall be holders of the 2026 RFEV Sailing Sport License

#### 4. ENTRIES

#### 5. FEES

- 5.1. The entry fee is 350,00 euro.
- 5.2. All socials in the schedule and craning and berthing fees are included in the entry fee.
- 5.3. The entry fees will be payable to the following account:

- 5.4. Late entries may be accepted after the 1st of September, with a payment of 75,00 euro together with the standard entry fee.

#### 6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. Registration  
Will be at the Regatta Office of the CdM from:  
Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October 1600- 1900 hrs.  
Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> October 1000- 1400 and 1600- 1900 hrs.
- 6.2. Launching and hauling up  
Launching slots will be available on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> October.  
Hauling up will be possible on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> after the last race and Sunday 11<sup>th</sup>

6.4. A total of 8 races is scheduled, with no more than 3 races per day.

6.5. Each day of racing there will be a briefing at 1000.

6.6. The first warning signal for subsequent days of the Championship will be noticed on the ONB by 1900 hrs on the day before the day's racing.

6.7. The intention is that there will be no more than two races a day. However, additional races may be sailed either in advance or arrears in order to complete the programme if weather or other reasons dictate.

6.8. On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1600 hrs.

Two tickets are allocated to each boat; extra tickets will be available to purchase nearer the event.

## **7. MEASUREMENT**

- 7.1. Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 7.2. Competitors will be required to complete a scrutinizing form (self-certification); forms will be available on the event website.
- 7.3. Boats may be inspected at any time during the event.
- 7.4. The fact that race officials may conduct inspections of a boat does not reduce the responsibilities of each competitor as set out in this Notice of Race.

## **8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 8.1. The sailing instructions will be available on the regatta website [no](#) later than 1200 on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2026 on the regatta website.

## **9. VENUE**

- 9.1. Appendix A shows the location of the regatta dock at CdM.
- 9.2. Appendix B shows the location of the racing area.

## **10. THE COURSES**

- 10.1. The courses to be sailed may comprise combinations of windward, leeward and reaching legs. The first windward leg should be at least 1.25 nm.

## **11. PENALTY SYSTEM**

- 11.1. RRS 44.1 is changed so that for incidents that occur outside a mark zone, the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 11.2 Any penalties incurred within the mark zone of mark 1a (windward mark) may be taken after rounding the mark 1b (offset mark) as per RRS 44.2.

## **12. SCORING**

- 12.1 Should entries justify it then a separate start for Classic and Silver Fleet boats, (cut off sail number 3200), may be considered
- 12.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.3 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

## **13. SUPPORT VESSELS**

- 13.1. [NP][DP] Support vessels shall be marked with International Code Flag Q.
- 13.2. There will be a briefing for all support person on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> October (time tbc), before the competitors briefing at the CdM.

## **14. [NP][DP] BERTHING & HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**

- 14.1. Without the express permission of the Regatta Office, no boat shall be ashore after Monday 6<sup>th</sup> at 2000 hrs. until she has finished her final race in the Championship.
  - 14.2. Boats shall be kept in their assigned locations while they are in the Club.
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## **15. [DP] DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS**

15.1. Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the European Championship.

## **16. [DP] RADIO COMMUNICATION**

16.1. The Race Committee may communicate using VHF. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

## **17. PRIZES**

17.1. Prizes will be given after the last race of the Regatta for:

- a) Winner Overall - Uffa Fox Memorial Trophy “2026 Flying Fifteen European Champion”
- b) Prizes for the first overall (one prize for each four boats).
- c) Prizes for Classic and/or Silver fleet boats dependent on the number of entries.

17.2. Other prizes may be announced in the SI or in the ONB.

## **18. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

18.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race.

18.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **19. INSURANCE**

19.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 2,000,000€ per incident or the equivalent.

## **20. FURTHER INFORMATION**

20.1. There will be an unofficial WhatsApp group for receiving general information from the Regatta Office. The QR Code will be provided for boats entering the event.
